The Pat Callahan Scholarship

Application Deadline: November 10, 2020

The Pat Callahan Scholarship will be awarded to two KSCSW members:

- One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a KSCSW member to assist with the cost of LCSW supervision.
- One \$750 scholarship will be awarded to a KSCSW member working toward advanced training in a specific clinical area.

Scholarship recipients will be competitively selected based on need and a statement concerning their commitment to a career in clinical social work.

1. The attached application form
2. A personal statement (maximum length 4 pages) introducing yourself to the selection committee and commenting on: your present and past work as a clinical social worker; your reasons for choosing this career; and the contribution to society that you hope to make through this career.
3. A statement of need – for the LCSW supervision scholarship only. (one page).

No incomplete or late applications will be accepted.

Scholarship recipients will be announced at the KSCSW Winter Conference on Friday December 4 at noon.
