SP201 is a culture and diversity-infused workshop for *clinicians, school counselors, crisis response staff, and other providers*. The workshop will provide instruction and a forum for clinical discussion and case practice on the current standards for suicide prevention and management. A usable framework and accessible guidelines will ensure that participants are able to competently manage suicide risk, incorporating the latest standards in suicide science and practice. Participants will learn to account for cultural influences on suicide risk and infuse key evidence-based cultural considerations throughout their suicide management activities.
